Note 1. We will be participating in the Brigantine Veterans' Day Ceremony on Sunday, 11 November. We may need parents to drive their cadets to/from Brigantine for this event. Be sure your Dress Blues are pressed and pay special attention to your grooming.

Note 2. Note to females: You are only allowed to wear one earring per ear, in the center of your earlobe, and it must be a uniform type earring. We do have them for sale for \$7 a pair, or you may get them elsewhere. Please do not wear anything else. Nothing in your nose or at the top of your ear. "I just had it done" is no excuse. You know when drill is every month, plan accordingly. You are also not allowed long, wildly colored fingernails. Colors must be conservative and fingernails should be no longer than ¼ past your fingertips.

Note3. We are going to play laser tag on Saturday afternoon at Lone Wolf Gaming in Egg Harbor Twp.

Be sure to dress for the weather - this is an outdoor facility. There will be a cost to cadets of \$15. This may be in the form of either cash or a money order. The Division will pay the rest of the cost. Your parents must complete the waiver (link provided on the "schedule" page) and you MUST bring it with you. We will need parents to help transport cadets to the facility. We will be dismissed from there. **PARENTS PLEASE BE SURE YOU KNOW WHERE THIS IS AND BE ON TIME.** The GPS address is 2590 Ridge Avenue, Egg Harbor Twp. This should be a really fun activity, and I hope all of you can attend. A big thanks to all of you who contacted PO3 Nowalsky and gave him your commitment.

Note 4. Important Money Reminders: 1) All payments for dues must be in the form of a MONEY ORDER ONLY made payable to "US Naval Sea Cadet Corps".. NO CHECKS AND NO CASH. 2) Please bring exact change (\$5) for lunch payments. Do NOT bring coins or large bills. We do not have a change fund, and if you bring a \$100 bill, you may not be able to get change. If everyone brings only \$10 or \$20 bills there will not be enough change for everyone. It also makes tracking payments more difficult. Plan ahead.

Note 5. Since this weekend is Veterans' Day, all cadets are to have a written or oral offering about Veterans' Day.
